

Pack 845 Perfect Attendance Award:

In order to receive the perfect attendance award in the pack a scout must meet the following expectations within the program year.

- Earn the National Summer Time Award
 - If Scout joins in fall recruiting this requirement is waived.
- Participate in four (4) service projects throughout the year.
 - Of the five, two (2) are required.
 - Scouting for Food (February)
 - RUMC Food drive (September)
- Attend Fall and Spring Camping Trips.
 - Winter trip is optional and can be used in place of Fall or Spring.
 - If spring trip is canceled, RSVP will be used in place of actual attendance.
- Den Participation
 - A Scout may miss two (2) scheduled den meetings per program year.
- Pack Meeting Participation
 - A Scout may miss one (1) scheduled pack meetings per year.
- Recruiting
 - Assisting with a recruiting event will be taken into consideration and can be used in place of one absence for a pack meeting.

This award will not be given at den meetings and will be awarded as part of the moving up ceremony in May of the program year. Just as a note, there is no den equivalent to this award and is a measure of attendance as a whole for the Scout participating in Den Activities and Pack functions.

Den leaders are responsible for updating attendance in the ScoutBook system. Den Leaders will need to provide pack meeting and pack activity attendance to the Cubmaster for entry into ScoutBook. This is due to a limitation in the calendar system that does not allow Den Leaders to enter attendance for non-den events.
